Jennifer Grey

Grey first gained widespread attention in the 1980s with roles in *Red Dawn* and *Ferris Bueller’s Day Off*, showcasing her versatility and on-screen charisma. The enduring popularity of *Dirty Dancing* cemented her status as a cultural icon of the decade. In 2010, she reintroduced herself to a new generation by winning season 11 of *Dancing with the Stars*. Grey has continued working steadily in film and television, earning admiration for her talent, longevity, and contributions to popular culture. Grey is currently teaming up with Lionsgate on the long-awaited sequel of *Dirty Dancing* which she will star in and executive produce.
